Position Overview

Duties: Under general supervision, evaluates and reviews designs, drawings and specifications for new buildings/structures and for renovation projects. Serves as the point of contact on construction projects for all building codes, applicable state, federal and local laws.

Minimum Qualifications (PG: 18):

Completion of an undergraduate degree in the Electrical Engineering discipline from an accredited college or university and three (3) years of diversified and related experience in design, construction document review, building/fire codes and construction administration. Must have a valid driver's license and the ability to travel statewide.

Minimum Qualifications (PG:19) Professional Engineer (PE):

Completion of an undergraduate degree in the Electrical Engineering discipline from an accredited college or university and four (4) years of diversified and related experience in design, construction document review, building/fire codes and construction administration. *Must have active Professional License in Electrical Engineering in the State of Georgia.* Must have a valid driver's license and the ability to travel statewide.

Competencies: Must demonstrate excellent interpersonal, organizational, analytical and communication skills and possess the ability to work effectively with a wide range of individuals in a diverse organization. Must possess the ability to read and interpret contracts, construction documents and Building and Life Safety Codes. Must exemplify leadership, personal initiative and be capable of planning and prioritizing work. Must be committed to quality service and possess the ability to identify solutions to complex problems. Must be time line driven. Considerable knowledge of building construction documents, Georgia State Minimum Standards, Georgia State Fire and Accessibility Codes and the Americans with Disability Act is required. Experience working with Microsoft Word and Excel.

If applying for a position that requires a degree, an official college transcript must be furnished. Only educational credentials from an accredited institution will be considered.
